○ What is school violence survey?

- ▶ School violence survey is carried out twice a year among 4th to 6th grade elementary school students and middle and high school students in order to study their experience and perception related to school violence.

○ Why do we need to join the survey?

- ▶ Through the anonymous survey students can share their candid opinions regarding school violence and also have a chance to contemplate on the issue once again
- ▶ By joining the survey, students can learn about which behaviors constitute school violence, how to deal with it in case such problem arises and why school violence is bad
- ▶ Survey results will serve as invaluable resources to make school free from concerns for school violence.

○ How and when should we join the survey?

- ▶ Students can easily participate in the survey from 24 March to 30 April through the National Education Information System (www.neis.go.kr). Personal information of students will be kept strictly confidential.
- ▶ Detailed instruction on how to join the survey will be made available through school authorities. Your attentions and participation will be highly appreciated.

Get tested for tuberculosis if a cough continues more than 2 weeks

- Tuberculosis(TB) is an infectious respiratory disease spread through coughs of active TB infection. Please get tested for TB if you cough more than two weeks.
- Hygiene/Cough Etiquette to prevent the transmission of respiratory infections including TB and influenza
 - ① When coughing, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue, a handkerchief or a sleeve rather than hand
 - ② Wash your hand with soap in running water after coughing or sneezing
- Vaccination against Tuberculosis(BCG) is to fend off severe tuberculosis among children and vaccination alone does not guarantee lifetime prevention of the disease
